# FINANCIAL GOAL \$200K

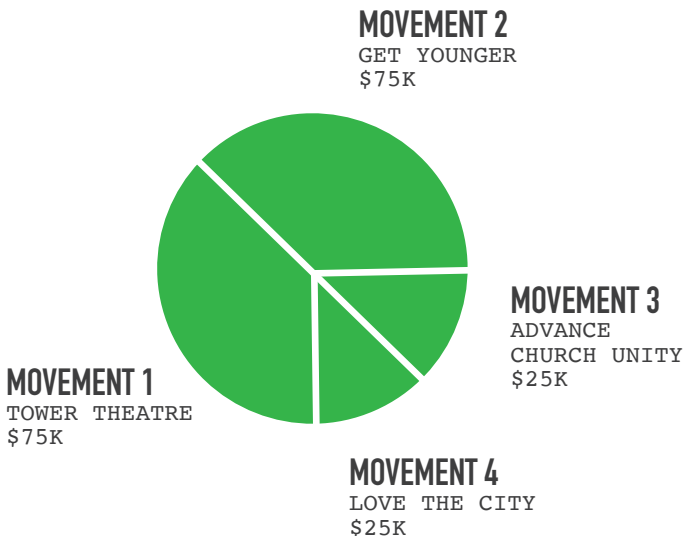
